LOW-THRESHOLD TESTING, COUNSELLING AND TREATMENT

FOR HIV & HEPATITIS C

reduce viral loads among the general population by Q10/ cases by Q50/

and cut down hepatitis C





OPIOID SUBSTITUTION THERAPY

reduces HIV infections among people who inject drugs by 54 %
